Decking boards were replaced on the lanai staircases around the West Pond. And general cleanup was done.

PRC roofing was here and did the finishing touches on the clubhouse building roof. Abbotts Construction was on the island to attempt to re attach the floating ferry dock landing piece. They were not successful with the equipment they had.

The captains have been busy with their usual duties and small maintenance projects. The docks were cleaned, skiff was cleaned, weeds were treated, roads graded, and some finishing touches were done on the new fuel storage fence on the mainland to strengthen the swing gates.
