Ferry Statistics

In order to evaluate the potential ferry schedule changes, the following data has been collected Dec 22, 2019 - Mar 21, 2020. This is 13 weeks of data. This data begins when we started collecting extra run data & ends before the effects of the COVID-19 crisis occurred.

Total # of Passengers (Tues - Thurs only)

- 2 weeks in Dec 922
- 4 weeks in Jan 1031
- 4 weeks in Feb 2249
- 3 weeks in Mar 1446

This is a total of 5648 passengers.

Extra Run Data (Tues - Thurs only)

- 2 weeks in Dec 11 extra runs
- 4 weeks in Jan 25 extra runs
- 4 weeks in Feb 43 extra runs
- 3 weeks in Mar 29 extra runs

This is a total of 108 extra runs. This averages out to 2.77 extra runs per day on Tues - Thurs.

WiFi Status

The work has finally begun to upgrade the WiFi at HBBC though the initial work has been fraught with issues.

The WiFi cable has been brought to the gazebo. An intermittent signal was determined to be due to a broken wire within the cable. The cable was replaced. The new transmitters were installed at the mainland gazebo and the caretaker's building. They tried to sync the signal without success. After contacting the manufacturer, it was determined that one of the transmitters was faulty. A replacement transmitter will be shipped & due to arrive later this week. Hopefully, the work will continue without further issues.

Ferry Schedule

The board has voted to make a change to the ferry schedule. The ferry is currently being run daily Monday - Friday at 9 AM to transport one of our daily service contractors off the island. Since the ferry is being run anyway, the board decided to make the 9AM permanent year round. All people will be able to take advantage of a one hour turn around. (Leave the island at 8AM, come back at 9AM Mon-Fri). The 1 PM ferry during the winter season will be eliminated. It was felt that the 1PM run was underutilized and created more issues than value for the Captain's schedule. This change will take effect on 9/14/2020.

There has been an ongoing discussion about changing the ferry schedule on Tue - Thurs during high season (Thanksgiving through Easter). The change would be from every 3 hours (8AM, 11AM, 1,PM, 2PM, 5PM, 8PM) to every 2 hours (8AM, 9AM, 10AM, 12PM, 2PM, 4PM, 6PM, 8PM). Currently we expect vendors to come to the island on a regularly scheduled ferry. We do not expect them to have to wait more than 1/2 hour for their return trip. This involves numerous extra trips during the week in addition to extra runs due to the passenger count. (See sidebar statistics) The HBBC board welcomes your input as we discuss this potential change.

I am excited & honored to have been asked by the Board to assume the position of President. I would like to thank Don Gagnon for his outstanding guidance and leadership through the past couple of years. Don navigated the community through the biggest challenges it has faced: the ferry, septic & dock rebuilds, caretaker turnover, and a fire suppression issue. Thanks Don. I only hope that I have learned from you.

I think it is important to understand why the Board takes certain actions. Recently, we have asked the Captains to strictly enforce requiring documentation of ownership or renter/guest rights when using our amenities. I can understand why some owners may be upset. This measure became necessary as we learned that homeowners on LGI & their renters were frequently using HBBC amenities, including our ferry. To control costs and to keep your fees as low as possible, we had to take these measures. I hope you understand. Please get to know your Captains and make sure renters & guests are given the appropriate documentation.

Looking forward, we are considering resurfacing options for the mainland parking lot, repowering the ferry, purchasing a used pontoon boat to reduce use of the ferry during slow times and options to improve drainage on roads at a reasonable cost.

I have a request of the owners. The Board frequently addresses issues that require someone with specialized knowledge. We can avoid increased costs if we can get assistance from our "internal resources" - you! If you have specialized knowledge or skill, please let Ed know. Although we understand that many of you do not have the time or interest to serve on the Board, if you can provide informal advice when needed, the community would appreciate it. I would like to obtain & maintain a list of owner/ experts for the Board to call upon when needed.
